THINGS TO KNOW

Our facility is opened, sanitized, and closed by a Foster Village Peoria Volunteer. They are not staff, and are not paid for their time. Please be respectful of the volunteers.

- Please arrive on time.
- Put toys away when done.
- Throw away wrappers & trash from food.
- Do not enter the visit room until the visit supervisor is there.
- Please respect our volunteers time and leave at the designated end time.
- Please be respectful while using the facility.
- Please let families using the space be aware that most questions or needs should be directed to the supervisor of the visit, unless it's a question about our space. Our volunteer is happy to help with finding bathrooms, the first aid kit, or adjusting the air conditioner unit.

REMINDER: When using our space for visits, a supervisor must be provided by agency or foster family. Our volunteer has not been trained & should not be involved in the visit or with individuals. Our volunteer will be in the Foster Village Office across the hall during the visit, per our contract agreement with University United Methodist Church. Also, we have a first aid kit available & can be requested if needed.
